

## NEW \* CELBAN PREPARATION AND ORIENTATION

### Course Description:

**\* This course has been revised to reflect recent changes to the official CELBAN test**

This course is designed to orient participants to the CELBAN test and provide practice in each task area of the CELBAN test. Communication objectives include:

- Speaking and listening skills for client assessments, health teaching, and interacting with colleagues
- Reading and listening strategies to focus on key information from healthcare resources and interactions
- Writing styles, structures and formats relevant to reporting, documentation and conveying opinions
- Communicating opinions, giving advice and responding to objections in the Canadian nursing context

This course will emphasize connecting communication skills to CELBAN test tasks and test-taking strategies. This course is also recommended for IENs working on communication skills readiness for nursing in Canada.
